Awards

Awards will be handed out at the conclusion of each trial. Ribbons are awarded for qualifying scores and High in Class. New title ribbons will be awarded. *Please let us know if you anticipate earning a larger title such as level 3 or above and what it is for*

Venue

The trial will be held at NBDSA NASDA Club, at our facility in Swainsboro, GA. All dogs must be under control and on leash when not competing. Please Do not let your dog potty in undesignated areas or on anything man-made. Please do not walk or allow dogs off leash on neighboring property as it does not belong to the venue host. Please clean up after yourself and your dog. There is a fenced off-leash potty yard that will be available, as long as it doesn't interfere with nearby search areas. ~Parking will be as you enter the property alongside the right side of driveway in designated parking spots. Exhibitors must crate in their vehicles. Potty areas will be in the grassy parking area and fenced yard area mentioned above (near parking area). Restroom and water on-site.

RV spots available \$20.00 dry camping only. You must reserve yours by emailing Cindy McManus at info@noblebeastsdogsports.com There are also many local campgrounds in the area.

Notice to Exhibitors: NBDSA reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made. Absolutely no alcohol or drug use allowed during the

trials. If suspected, you will be asked to leave immediately with no refund and your entries will not be accepted at any future NBD SA events.

Refunds for entries requested before the closing date will be issued through Secreterrier. Mailed in entries will be mailed 7 days after the event. *No refund for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the decision of the Trial Committee.*

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing. Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run. Please be courteous and pick up after your dog. Bitches in Season may compete in the event. The Trial Secretary must be notified in advance, BIS will run last in their class, and panties must be worn when dog is outside of vehicle (except to potty). A potty area near the parking area will be designated for BIS.

Move ups from Trial to Trial and Day to Day are allowed. A move up form must be completed for Day to Day Move Ups. Judge & Trial Secretary must be notified in advance for Trial to Trial moveups.

Entries All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. You can enter and Pay thru below mail in form (\$2.00 Fee per run) or Secreterrier.com *ENTERING TRIALS: Dog Registration: Dogs must be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association before you enter a trial. NASDA registration is a one-time fee. You may register your dog online at <http://nasda.dog/registration>. You will receive their NASDA # which you will need to enter this trial. Secreterrier is a Trial Secretary program that streamlines the entire trial secretary process and makes entering and tracking events and results by competitors a breeze! Competitor Benefits:

Entry Tips:

- PAT (Puppy Aptitude Test) is open to puppies 4 months to 9 months of age.
- Dogs six months of age and older who have not yet earned a title will start in Level I.
- After earning a title in Level I, the dog can progress(move up) to Level II and also continue to compete during the same trial for Level I Q's to earn a Level I X title.
- Check ☐ the Level(s) you want to enter for that day and class.
- Check ☐ each of the trials for each class that you want to enter that day. You can enter none, one, all and any combination for each day/class. There are no resets for Level III.
